This type of platform lift can be secured with a pin after sliding the platform onto the forks. The industrial lift platform provides extra protection with three rails and a safety screen covering the rear. For additional safety, it is a good idea to consider choosing a style which opens through the front railing rather than the side gate unit.

Stock pickers can attach onto a forklift utilizing the same foundations as other platforms but are much different. Stock pickers often have a much slighter base surrounding by a front guard partition and railings on three sides. This particular unit differs from the other platforms in view of the fact that the cage and the surface do not take up the entire fork surface area.
